THE TERROIR INFLUENCE ON WINE:

Loazzolo is located in a microclimate whose conditions are particularly favorable for growing Pinot Nero. The altitude, sun exposure (specifically fresher verses east and west), the temperature range, the poor soil and calcium all ever changing due to the vintage and climate conditions, are all conditions that help to enrich Pinot Nero, forcing us to constantly seek out the right equilibrium between acidity and tannins, and slowing the maturation to bring forth it's natural perfumes.

Monferrato bianco D.O.C. Cardonnay

THE TERROIR INFLUENCE ON WINE:

Freshness and minerality in taste are accompanied by an intense white flower bouquet, which fully express the Chardonnay characteristics. The vine are grown above 500m asl. High hill Chardonnay has minerality and elegance as its main features.

The vines are at the highest point of the estate vineyard, cultivated at 540 meters above sea level, which renders a stronger thermal range in August and September.

Loazzolo ecosystem preservation

CO2 compensation: we measure it through the woods that naturally coexist with vineyard, we are in credit after the calculation of CO2 production concerning wine delivered from wheel transport. We do not use chemical herbicides



The heroic experiment

In our vineyards find space acclimated grapes such as Pinot and Cabernet.

In 2007 we planted "la Vela" (translated "the Wing") a Pinot Nero vineyard considered unique for extreme characteristics in slope terms and % of vines per hectare (over 11.000).
